


1. The noseclip is located in the top panel. Pre-form the noseclip by gently bending at the centre of the panel. Hold the respirator in one hand and pull out the bottom panel to form a cup.




Turn respirator over to expose headbands.




 Cup respirator under chin. Ensure the two straps are separated and pull the straps over the head, one at a time.



4. Locate the lower strap below the ears and the upper strap across the crown of the head. Adjust top and bottom panels for a comfortable fit.



Note - do not use with beards or other facial hair that may prevent contact between the face and edge of the respirator.



If you cannot achieve a proper fit do not re-enter the contaminated area. See your supervisor.
